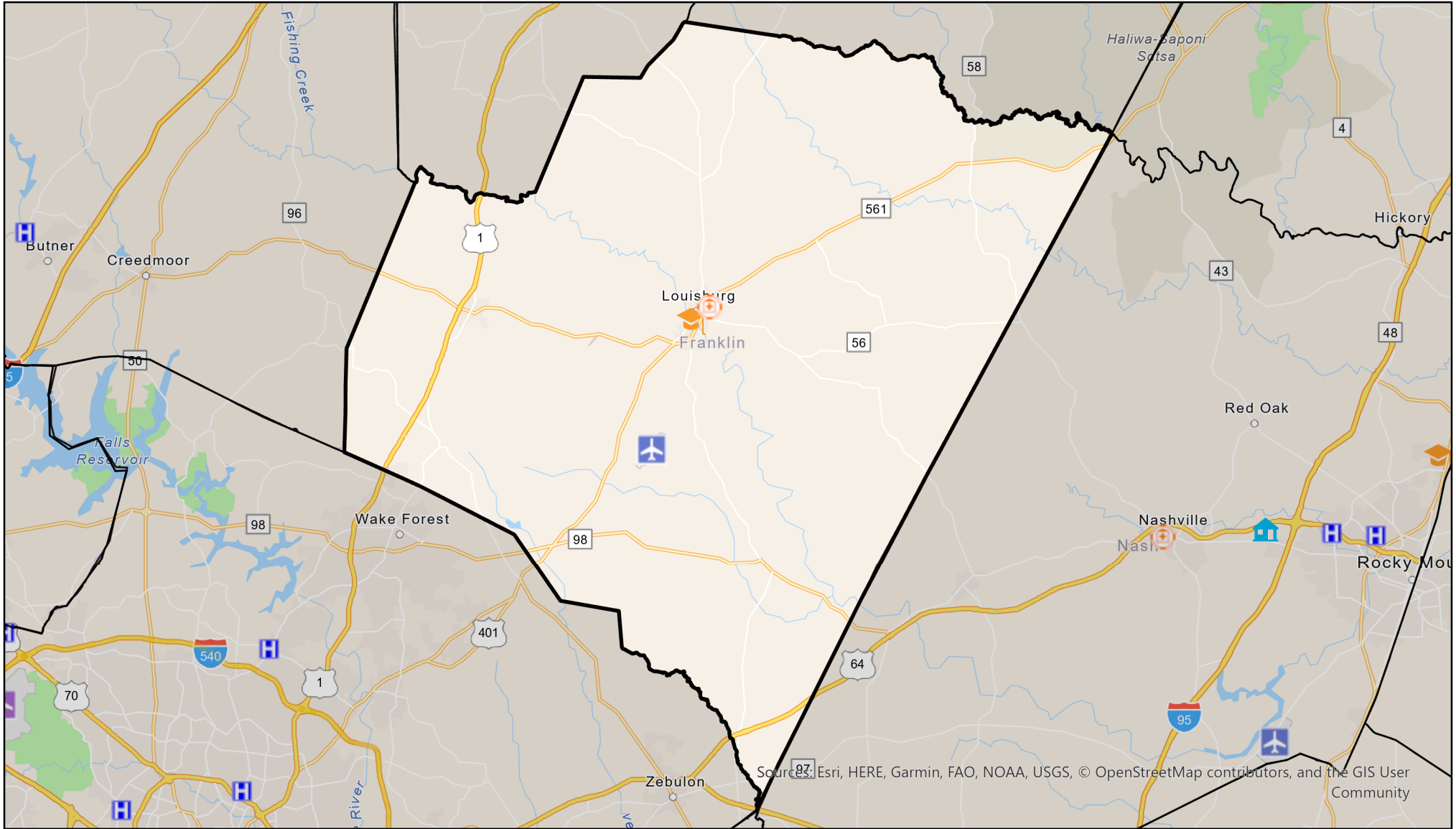

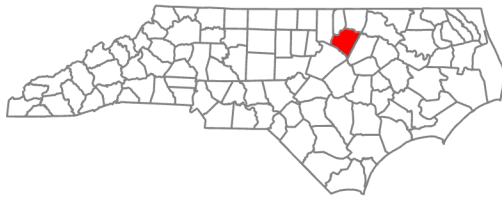
Notes:
