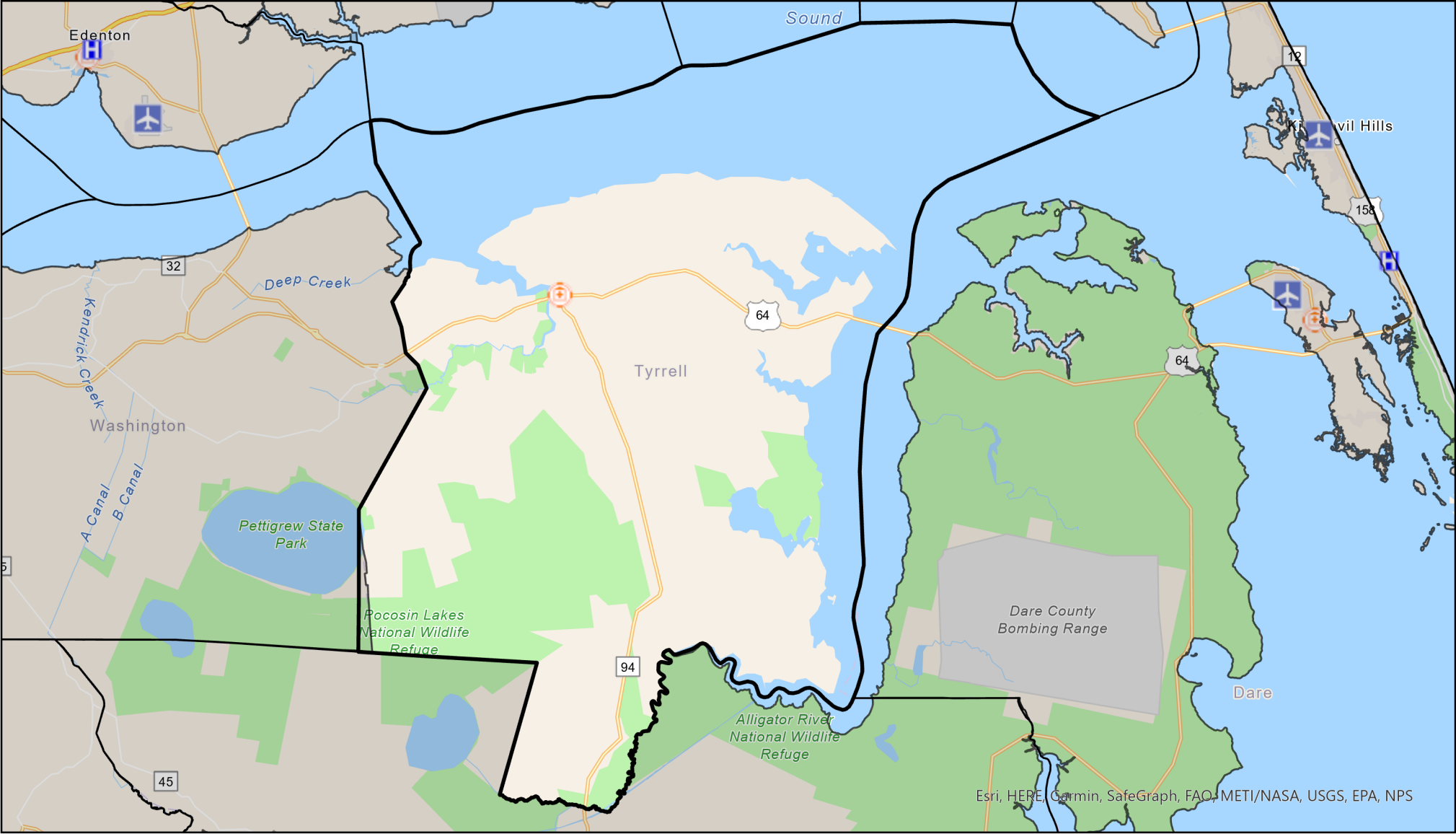

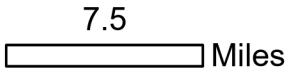
### Notes:
